General Description

This position will work in collaboration with the Georgia Legal Services Program, Farmworker Rights Division to provide specialized outreach to the farmworker community in South Georgia with a focus to identify victims of human trafficking and provide them with information and referrals to services. The outreach coordinator will be responsible for weekly travel to South Georgia.

Responsibilities

- Develop a monthly outreach plan in collaboration with Georgia Legal Services.
- Conduct weekly outreach activities
- Facilitate referrals of farmworkers to appropriate legal or social services providers as needed.
- Develop and maintain a tracking system for outreach activities
- Assist in developing and distributing outreach material (e.g. fliers, pamphlets)
- Participate in community outreach events
- Attend Agriculture Task Force meetings on a quarterly basis

Qualifications

- Minimum education of a Bachelor's degree or an equivalent degree in Latin American Studies, Political Science, Religious Studies, Sociology and Psychology. Other majors will be considered in addition to work experience
- Background-cleared
- Familiarity with issues of refugee and immigrant victims
- Bilingual (Spanish) required
- Good writing skills
- Familiarity with MS Office
- Flexible schedule including evenings and weekends
- Reliable transportation and willingness to travel throughout the state of Georgia
